How to get here

FLY HERE from Stockholm Arlanda International Airport (ARN) to Luleå Airport (LLA) or Kiruna Airport (KRN). Option to fly from Luleå Airport (LLA) to Pajala Airport (PJA). You can also choose to fly to Helsinki (HEL) and connect to Rovaniemi (RVN), Kittilä (KTT) or Kemi (KEM) in Finland, since Heart of Lapland borders to Finland. Some airlines offer direct flights to northern Sweden and Finland from European airports. Both Finland and Sweden are a part of Schengen, making the border crossing simple.

THE NIGHT TRAIN from Stockholm is a comfortable option. It passes by Boden, Luleå, Gällivare and Kiruna, where you can continue by car or bus. You can also take the train into Heart of Lapland and stop in either Haparanda or Kalix.

DRIVE HERE or getting around is easiest with a car. The international E-road network crossing Heart of Lapland includes E4, E8 and E10. You can rent a car at the airports. Please note that crossing the border with a rental car may include additional fees.

PRIVATE TRANSFER from the airport or train station is offered by several accommodation providers. The private transfers are usually guided transfers, with a guide as chauffeur, or even the owner themselves. A great way to be introduced to Heart of Lapland. Ask about transfers upon booking your stay.





WHITEFISH GRILLING IN THE TIMBER SMOKE HUT

The Kukkola village is known for the way of grilling whitefish. The fish is first put on a stick and then grilled over an open fire. The Timber Smoke Hut, one of the oldest buildings in the Kukkola cultural village, is from the 1700s. During the grilling of the fish, you get to hear about the methods of preparing fish as well as the fishing culture along the Torne River. If whitefish is not available, grilling will be done with fresh salmon. Flatbread and hot juice is served with the fish. Enjoy a tasty meal around the fire.



FISHING WHITEFISH WITH A BAG NET

Try the traditional way of catching whitefish in Kukkola village, dating back to the 1500s. Step out on the "pata" – a wooden pier that is rebuilt every summer – with your bag net that sits at the end of a 6-meter-long handle. A good fisherman needs to know the resting places of the fish as well as have strength to fish for hours at a time. Learn the special fishing technique together with a guide. The fishing season starts at the end of May and finishes in September.

GROUP SIZE: 4 persons Available for bigger groups 5-20 people with just a few minutes fishing / person.

SAUNA SPA

Combine training and relaxing in this active version of the sauna evening. The method increases metabolism, removal of toxins and has positive effect on sleeping. The 30-minute training session is done in a mild 40-50 degrees warm sauna, which ends with a natural face mask and foot bath. You can choose to continue with a regular sauna evening after the training session.



BAKING IN THE TIMBER SMOKE HUT

One of the oldest buildings in the Kukkola cultural village is the Timber Smoke Hut, dating back to the 1700s, which has been used for many generations when grilling whitefish. In addition to the traditional grilling, you can also bake bread on an open fire. While baking, you will hear about the food traditions and the culture of Torne Valley. After the baking you will enjoy the bread with delicious whitefish filling. Warm juice is also served from a traditional Sami drinking cup, kuksa.


DINNER ON THE RIVER



The reindeer is both a symbol and the backbone of Sámi culture. At Kaatis Reindeers, you are guided by the Sámi woman Anna-Lena, through the traditions and history of Sápmi. You will get a deep insight into the connection to nature and the circle of life. Meet the reindeer up close, learn about the life with reindeer and feed them with goodies from nature. All activities are made with respect for the animal. Anna-Lena also has a small shop where she sells local handicraft.

SLEEP AND EAT AMONGST THE REINDEER

Experience a magical overnight stay in the middle of a reindeer enclosure. Sleep in a Sámi tent or under the open sky, surrounded by the majestic reindeer. You'll have a unique opportunity to immerse yourself in Sámi culture through stories, traditions, and the beautiful animals.

Anna-Lena Kaati, a Sámi and your host, invites you to Kaatis Reindeers Camp, where she shares personal stories about her Sámi culture and history. You'll stay in a Tentipi tent on soft reindeer skins and a bed of spruce branches – just like a traditional reindeer herder – while the reindeer graze and rest nearby. Enhance your stay with authentic Sámi activities, nature experiences, and outdoor dining options. This overnight stay offers a genuine and unforgettable insight into Sámi life.

SEASON July 1-September 30

Norrbottens Destilleri is a small-batch distillery in Töre SE, making spirits from organic ingredients grown in responsibly farmed soils near and far. Here, close to the Arctic Circle, the weather is dramatic, the flora wild, and the distances long. It's a region where you make the most of what nature provides while ensuring you protect the ecosystem that supports local plants and animals. This North Bothnian way of doing things is the heart of the destillery – sourcing and distilling in harmony with nature, making sure the use of natural resources never exceeds nature's regenerative ability.

The unifying principle of every Norrbottens Destilleri product are fusions. That means thoughtfully selected organic raw materials combined in ways that add new layers of taste. The result is a product from Norrbotten.

The founder Dennis Bejedal, is a self-taught distiller. He was born in Stockholm and is now rooted in Pålänge, a small village of roughly 400 inhabitants in the far north of Sweden. A former professional poker player who has traveled the world extensively, Dennis started Norrbottens Destilleri in 2016 to indulge his obsession with taste and aroma. His entry into the distilling world liberated his creativity, allowing him to fully immerse himself in the experimental possibilities of flavor and deliciousness.







Kattilakoski Restaurant as a place for upscale casual dining has quickly become a popular destination among both locals and tourists since its opening in May 2024. The Australian chef Taz Huggins and sommelier Henrik Berg run the restaurant, with the river rapids outside sharing the restaurant's name. Kattilakoski translates to *pot rapid*, and the rushing water is imitating a boiling pot of water.



They also have an excellent selection of local and Swedish non-alcoholic beverages, as well as a wine list focusing on small-scale producers from Europe, of internationally high quality – a true treasure trove for wine lovers.

The restaurant is fully committed to using local products from the area and wine from select producers in Europe, contributing to both a circular economy and a reduced environmental footprint. 














Arthotel Tornedalen




